The annual report presented here covers the academic session 2022-23 of grade I / II. The session commenced in the month of April 2022 and ended on march 28, 2023. The Academic session of 2022-23 was divided into two terms: Term I (June – October) and Term II (November-March) followed by Periodic Assessments (I/II). The total strength of the classes as follows:

Grade: I (Sun/Moon): 87
Grade: II (Sun/Moon): 77

Under the exemplay guidance of Principal sir, the teaching-learning process was designed as per the 360 holistic assessment. Keeping in mind the 21<sup>st</sup> century Learning skills, based on 4cs, FLIPS, and IMT, the teaching learning Process emphasised more on activity/ Project oriented teaching along with subject enrichment activities. The focus was primarily more on the concepts to be reached to the learners. A wide ranging activitieson Grammer were introduced to the learners for conceptual clarity and better understanding of the same. These wide ranging activities/ games focuses on the following areas:

- a) reading skills
- b) writing skills
- c) communication skills
- d) analytical skills
- e) listening skills
- f) Socializing Skills

Alongside, the young learners were also introduced to the concept of S.E.M (Self Evaluation Method) and to the techniques of life skills management that enable the young learners to cope with the emotional issues.
